OUR CO-CURRICULAR ploghamme

Our large and varied co-curricular programme develops Pupils' skills, experiences and confidence. Pupils are encouraged to pursue their interests, to challenge themselves, and to try out new activities, laying out a foundation for pupils to build and develop a lifelong passion.

Our co-curricular programme varies each term. Our most recent clubs include; STEM Club, Culture Club, Chess Club and Craft Club, to name just a few.



In the Summer Term, we hold Activities Week for pupils in Key Stage 3 (Years 7-9). During this week the usual School timetable is suspended, and pupils are given the opportunity to participate in a wide range of additional activities. Examples include; Galactic Golf, Team Building, Lazer Zone and tours of Richmond Castle and the National Space Centre. We also have large numbers of pupils taking part in the Duke of Edinburgh Programme, offering pupils the opportunity to take part in a range of activities including volunteering and expedition planning.

Sport is a big part of life at Silcoates. Pupils have access to our onsite Swimming Pool and new state of the art Fitness Suite. We encourage pupils to explore a wide range of sports, including; Rugby, Football, Hockey, Netball and Cricket, with regular opportunities to represent the School each Saturday in competitive fixtures.

Music also plays a large role in many pupil's Silcoates experience. Pupils have the opportunity to take individual music lessons, and are encouraged to take part in concerts, school productions and musicals throughout the year.

Day to day, our pupils have access to a wide range of day trips and residentials linked to their studies, examples include; The East Yorkshire Coast, Yorkshire Sculpture Park, Shakespeare's Globe, Lockerbrook Farm Outdoor Centre, Skiing in Italy, with more long haul destinations including South Africa and Dubai for our Bi Annual sports tours.

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
















Silcoates actively encourages teamwork, effort and achievement. Our House System is central to this, and all pupils and staff are assigned a House when they join the School. Our houses are named after our former Heads -Evans', Moore's, Spencer's and Yonge's. Our Houses also have 'A Person of Inspiration' assigned to them, which is selected by pupils each year. Selection is based on who they find inspirational to them outside of School life. In 2022 this included Colin Kaepernick and Dame Deborah James.

The house system is a huge part of School life and allows pupils from all ages to meet and mix with their peers in other forms and year groups. House events take place weekly, and are fiercely competitive. Past events have included: Science, FIFA, Rugby, Music and Badminton competitions. The winning house each year is celebrated at Speech Day, where the Head of House and House Prefect collect the much-coveted Pearson Cup.

Our Upper Sixth students are invited to apply for prefectships at the end of their Lower Sixth year, a pivotal part of this is the house prefect role. A prefect is selected to represent each house, and takes a leadership role in events throughout the year.
